The 5 Major Scale Positions | Deft Digits Guitar Lessons

The major scale is the mother of all scales and your reference point for all other scales. That's why it's so important to master all of these five scale shapes. The five C-A-G-E-D scale shapes (C shape, A shape, G shape, E shape and D shape) surround the entire fretboard. The "shapes" are sometimes also referred to as "positions".

The 5 Pentatonic Scale Shapes - Guitar Lesson

The root note of each shape determines the name of the scale. In the examples below all the scale shapes are in the key of G, so all the root notes are G notes. Each shape is moveable so you can play these shapes in every key. For example, if you move the entire scale shape up a whole step (2 frets)...

Positions of the Pentatonic Scale for Guitar

On guitar, we can play any scale in 5 different positions on the neck. This is the same scale, same note names, just in different locations on the neck. But what does this really mean?

The CAGED System And The Importance Of Five Positions ...

If you hear someone mention that a piano sonata by the composer and pianist Franz Schubert is played in A Major, it means that it depends on the A Scale. You can scroll down and see illustrations of all Major scales, further down you will see an overview with all the notes and the intervals, semi-tones, and finally the formula of the Major Scale.

All Scales in All Positions for Guitar - A Pocket ...

This lesson is about "unboxing" the Major Scale by visualising seven positions. The easiest way to do this is by building patterns on each degree of the scale in question. In this case, the Major Scale, that's seven degrees, with 1 being its root or 1st degree, right up to the 7th degree.

Should I learn all scales in all positions on the guitar ...

The first position of the major scale, seen above, is the "standard" way of playing the major scale, which most guitarists know. If it looks unfamiliar to you, play through it. This is the "do re mi fa sol la ti do" scale you probably learned in school.

Piano Major Scales - overview with pictures

All you have to do is emphasize the E notes in your scale shapes and they become E minor pentatonic scale shapes. Below you can see this scale is the exact same shape as our "Shape #5". The only difference is the location of the root notes, which have changed from all the G notes to all the E notes.
