Phoenician ivories were traded all over the Middle East and Mediterranean. They have been found in excavations on Crete PGP and Cyprus PGP , as well as Etruria PGP in central Italy . Equally, Assyrian craftsman developed their own local style of ivory carving, which was much less ornate (Image 1).

The ivories comprise plaques decorated in relief with intricate carvings of sphinxes, lions, serpents, people, flowers and geometric motifs, as well as carvings of female heads and female figurines. They were carved in various locations across the Ancient Near East, including Egypt, modern Syria and Lebanon, with relatively few carved locally.

Naeh reviews recent wood, bone and ivory finds from the sites of Jerusalem, Rehov and Hazor in Israel to shed light on the Samaria ivories.
