Assessment of Waste Management Practices among Residents ...

The results of the assessment revealed that the average solid waste, generated by a household in a week, was 1.25 Kurtu with a minimum of 0.25 'Kurtu' and a maximum of 3 'Kurtu'. Among 350 households, 328 (93.7%) had a solid waste storage receptacle, used to store solid wastes, and 22 (6.3%) did not have any.
