Student pilots must pass a General English Language Proficiency (GELP) test to begin training, but to sit for PPL or above licence you must pass an Aviation English Language Proficiency (AELP) test. If you are a 'native' English speaker with ICAO Level 6 English proficiency, your Flight Examiner may be authorised to give you a Level 6 assessment.

Failure to reach the Expert level will require retesting at least once every 3 years if the test results place the pilot at Operational or every 6 years if Extended. This standard is designed to improve the ATC communication process
