Speech Bubbles: Drama for Communication

This might also include thought bubbles for characters. Remove speech bubbles from a comic strip. Cut them up and give out. Ask them to order them and to imagine what the story or situation is.

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Groups can act out their version for the class. Then give them the comic strip and ask them to see if their speech bubbles fit the story there.
