The reproductive systems develop from several structures and require several chemical substances. Gonads develop from intermediate mesoderm that gives rise to gonadal ridges. Mesonephric (Wolffian) ducts develop into the male reproductive system. Paramesonephric (Mullerian) ducts develop into the female reproductive system.
