The tense of a verb indicates the time of the action or of the state of being expressed by the verb. The time of an action or state of being can be past,

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present, or future. Each verb has six tenses. The six tenses express time in different ways. Here are three of the tenses.

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Active and Passive Voice A verb in the active voice expresses an action done by its subject. A verb in the passive voice expresses action done to its subject.
