Data classification is the process of separating and organizing data into relevant groups (“classes”) based on their shared characteristics, such as their level of sensitivity and the risks they present, and the compliance regulations that protect them. To protect sensitive data, it must be located, then classified according to its level of sensitivity and tagged.
