It shows you an easy way to focus on teaching them the core (or pivotal) responses to be functional communicators and students: motivation, responsive to multiple cues from teacher, self-management, etc. Teaching these will lay a foundation for these kids to overcome their deficit of inattention/lack of auditory processing in gaining cues.

Steps for Implementation: Pivotal Response Training

Pivotal Response Training (PRT) Provides intensity of intervention through parent training—parents are taught to provide active behavioral learning opportunities as often as possible Based on principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) • Contingent learning opportunities (A-B-C learning contingency) • Goal directed

Classroom Pivotal Response Teaching (CPRT)

PRT focuses on “pivotal” skills that are thought to open gates of instruction. For instance, teaching a student to focus on multiple cues at one time allows him to take in more information more efficiently and learn in a wider variety of environments. Initiation is another pivotal skill.

Pivotal Response Training (PRT) is a naturalistic, behavioral intervention with a strong evidence-base that is designed to increase generalization and maintenance of responding in children with ASD. Although special education teachers report using PRT, little research to date has examined PRT use in the context of community school programs.

Classroom Pivotal Response Teaching (CPRT) - CASRC | UC ...

First called pivotal response teaching, PRT combined several research-based interventions to improve autistic children's social and communicative growth. A study published in Behavior Modification journal showed that pivotal response treatment is highly effective for preschool, elementary, and middle school students with ASD.
