Introduction. Recurrent uncomplicated urinary tract infection (UTI) is a common presentation to urologists and family doctors. Survey data suggest that 1 in 3 women will have had a diagnosed and treated UTI by age 24 and more than half will be affected in their lifetime. 1 In a 6-month study of college-aged women, 27% of these UTIs were found to recur once and 3% a second time. 2

Atrophic vaginitis is inflammation of the vagina as a result of tissue thinning due to not enough estrogen. Symptoms may include pain with sex, vaginal itchiness or dryness, and an urge to urinate

International recommendations on the diagnosis and ...

Mycoplasma pneumoniae causes community-acquired pneumonia and upper respiratory illness.. Infection is often seen in close community settings, such as boarding schools, army bases, universities, and hospitals.
