A manual transmission requires the driver to shift the gears themselves. It will have three pedals: clutch, brake and accelerator to operate the vehicle. The clutch pedal is located at the far left and is used when upshifting or downshifting. The clutch is disengaged when the pedal is pushed to the floor. The middle pedal is the brake.
