Some ocular adverse effects may be reversed with medical or surgical intervention whereas other drugs may cause irreversible loss of vision. The risk of visual loss can be reduced by a number of approaches, including monitoring for ocular toxicity, reducing the drug dose, or stopping the drug and looking for an alternative.
