In its 1999 report on ensuring the quality of cancer care, the IOM elaborated on this definition and defined poor quality as “overuse (e.g., unnecessary tests, medication, and procedures, with associated risks and side effects); underuse (e.g., not receiving lifesaving surgical procedures); or misuse (e.g., medicines that should not be given together, poor surgical technique)” (IOM and NRC, 1999, p. 79).
