Handwriting copying speed A copying test, The Handwriting Speed Test (Wallen et al., 1996) was used to assess handwriting speed, giving a score in letters per minute (LPM). This test was designed and standardised for children in Australia, although not for the English context or for children below Year 4 (8-9 year olds).
