Originally signed into law in 1975, the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) is the main federal statute governing special education for children. Today, IDEA protects the rights of over six million students with disabilities (approximately 13.5 percent of students) to receive a Free Appropriate Public Education in the least restrictive environment.

In 1975, IDEA became law and brought with it revolutionary changes for children and youth with disabilities, their families and the professionals who work on their behalf. Since its inception, IDEA has revolutionized the educational and workplace opportunities available to America's 6.9 million children and youth with disabilities.

Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)

Part C of IDEA recognizes the need for identifying and reaching very young children with disabilities. This portion of IDEA provides guidelines concerning the funding and services to be provides to children from birth through 2 years of age. Families are entitled to several services through part C of IDEA (IDEA, 1997).
