IP - Inward Processing. IP is used to obtain relief from customs duties & VAT on goods bound for manufacturing and subsequent re-export. Production runs must be completed in an agreed and authorised timeframe to avoid incurring duty, but equivalent products and prior exporting can mitigate duty liabilities.

"Duty relief" is a customs process that allows certain goods to be imported without payment of customs duties provided that they are then re-exported. This relief from duties could be for a number of activities including:

- Temporary admission for re-exportation in the same state;
- Temporary admission for inward processing;

INWARD PROCESSING RELIEF (IPR). Inward Processing Relief (IPR) is a method of obtaining relief from Customs duties and VAT charges. The relief applies to goods imported from outside the EU, processed and exported to countries outside the EU. IPR provides relief to promote exports from the EU and assist EU companies to compete on an equal footing in the world market.

Inward Processing (IP) is the term used to describe a duty relief procedure.
