CF is the base of this triangle so we connect C and F with a segment and find its midpoint G. Drawing a perpendicular bisector of CF through G gives us a line that the center of the tangent circle lies on so we can find the intersection of our two lines to find the location of the center of our tangent circle.

A "Mark's Cross" is a set of perpendicular Lines of Forbiddance in a four-point circle. It can be attached to a bindpoint of a larger circle for support.
