Apple discontinued the AirPort and AirPort Express line of Wi-Fi devices in April 2018. Because the hardware is no longer being sold and the software no longer being maintained by Apple, we are no longer updating this article. The AirPort Express is still available on the secondary market, though.

The base station network name is set to "Apple Network," followed by the last six digits of the base station's MAC address. The base station won't be visible in the Wi-Fi status menu or AirPort Utility for up to a minute. You may then use the device in its default state or reconfigure it using AirPort Utility.
