1 Select preset manual white balance. Press and hold the button and rotate the main command dial until (Preset manual) is displayed in the monitor. 2 Select a preset. Keeping the button pressed, rotate the sub-command dial until the desired white balance preset (d-1 to d-6) is displayed.

Because you are setting your white balance and the camera is not playing any part, the color cast doesn't play a part when white balance is being set (which is possible when using a gray card or AWB). 3. Much quicker than getting out the gray card for changes in location! 4. More consistent white balance than AWB. 5. More accurate exposure.

10 Steps to Manual Mode: White Balance

In adjusting white balance, the goal is to have the color temperature such that white appears as neutral white. Note in the image above that the woman's dress is a bright white. That's because the color is balanced. If it wasn't balanced, the dress might appear to have a color cast to it - blue or orange, for example.

How to Set White Balance - Ken Rockwell

To manually set the white balance in your image, you first point your camera at a pure white object, set the exposure and focus. Now, activate the white balance on the object by pressing the button. It may take a few seconds for the camera to perceive the shot, but it will this color setting until the next white balance is performed.

When Preset manual is selected for white balance, you can press the WB button to enter direct measurement mode. PRE will flash in the display; tap a white or grey object to position the spot white balance target () over the selected object and measure white balance. To zoom in on the target for precise positioning, press the button.

The last (and easiest way) to fix white balance is to do it in Lightroom or Photoshop when you are editing your photos. To do this, you use the white balance dropper tool and click on something in the photo that is true white, black or grey. By clicking on this, the computer will adjust the white balance of the photo to a neutral tone.

Just like setting the white balance in your camera, you can manually set the white balance either by adjusting the temperature value or by using the eyedropper tool on the left side and clicking on a neutral or white part of the image. In general terms, setting white balance manually involves taking a photo of something white or mid-gray in the same light which is illuminating your intended subject. Next, you select your camera's Custom White Balance mode, and tell the camera to use the photo you just took of the white or mid-gray content as a reference.
