To get a license (and keep it), the OLCC requires producers to abide by a number of regulations.

The legalization of recreational marijuana through Measure 91 doesn't affect Oregon's medical marijuana program. The Oregon Medical Marijuana Act protects users from criminal charges concerning possession, production, and delivery. Oregon has had a medical marijuana program since 1998. Under this program, indoor marijuana growing in Oregon was permitted for up to 6 mature plants. The program even allowed patients to have up to 18 seedlings at a time.
