Prevailing features of Memphis design: Laminate and Terrazzo materials, which were usually found on floors, were incorporated into tables and lamps. Squiggles, aka the Bacterio print, was designed by Sottsass in 1978. Bright, multi-colored objects with a rejection of typical shapes.
