Blue oat grass, Helictotrichon, zones 3 to 8 and blue fescue, Festuca (zones 3 or 4 to 8 are shorter grasses with blue foliage. The ornamental and native sedges (Carex) and Hakone grass (Hakonechloa macra) can be a little more challenging but most do well in shady locations.

Cool season grasses are best for zone 3 lawns. These grasses grow in spring and fall when the soil is at 55 to 65 degrees Fahrenheit (12-18 C.).
