Core tip: Patients present with foot and ankle problems can have either single or multiple pathologies. Obtaining adequate history and performing good clinical examination is a key in reaching the accurate diagnosis. Adjuvant tools like radiological images can be used to confirm what has been clinically suspected.

Physical Examination of the Hip Outline

The initial physical and orthopaedic examination must be consistent and thorough. These assessments are generally carried out concurrently in order to minimize patient manipulation and attendant discomfort.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION: Examination of the head reveals a laceration in the occipital region, sutures in place. Examination of the eardrums reveals no hemotympanum, reveals them to be intact bilaterally. No raccoon eyes or Battle sign. The patient does have infraorbital ecchymosis on the right eye. No ocular involvement.

CHAPTER 6

The physical examination must include a thorough inspection of the overlying soft tissues (with documentation). If the fracture is open, a clinical photograph may be taken for documentation purposes and to avoid multiple clinicians having to take down dressings to observe the wound.
