### Clinical electrocardiography and ECG interpretation - ECG ...

Checklist. QRS duration must be  $<0,12$  s (normally 0,07-0,10 s).; There must be at least one limb lead with R-wave amplitude  $>5$  mm and at least one chest (precordial) lead with R-wave amplitude  $>10$  mm; otherwise there is low voltage.; High voltage exists if the amplitudes are too high, i.e if the following condition is satisfied: S-wave V1 or V2 + R-wave V5  $>35$  mm.

Maximal stress testing involves increasing the intensity level until you can no longer keep up, either because you are winded or the ECG indicates this there is a cardiac problem. The goal of maximal testing is to provide evidence of CAD. The test can last from six to 15 minutes, sometimes less, depending on your cardiovascular fitness level.
