Reflection on the learning When students become reflective about the teaching and learning process, they are strengthening their own capacity to learn. Central to this is the principal of reflection as metacognition, where students are aware of and can describe their thinking in a way that allows them to "close the gap" between what they know and what they need to learn.

Most educators believe that reflection is useful in the learning process, even without the supporting research data. However, it is often difficult to encourage reflection among the learners. Gustafson and Bennett (1999) found that promoting reflection among military cadets by means of written responses in diaries or journals was difficult.

Prior to each instructional evaluation conference, the teacher writes a reflection that accurately identifies specific alternatives to improve unsuccessful teaching. After determining the lessons strengths and weaknesses, effective teachers identify specifically how his/her future actions will be informed and improved by what has been learned.

There is one quality above all that makes a good teacher \pm the ability to reflect on what, why and how we do things and to adapt and develop our practice within lifelong learning. Reflection is the key to successful learning for teachers, and for learners.

Reflecting on experiences encourages insight and complex learning. We foster our own growth when we control our learning, so some reflection is best done alone. Reflection is also enhanced, however, when we ponder our learning with others. Reflection involves linking a current experience to previous learnings (a process called scaffolding). Reflection also involves drawing forth cognitive and emotional information from several sources: visual, auditory, kinesthetic, and tactile.

Learning reflections such as this call for affirmative action, and critical thinking about what learning and knowledge are for. You can challenge learners to have open discussions about how best they can use what you teach them. Have them think personally, locally, and globally about how their learning connects them to living once school is over.
