Cranial cross-sectional anatomy is very important to know prior to analyzing a head CT. Once the normal structures are identified, abnormalities can be detected and a diagnosis may be possible. Symmetry is an important concept in anatomy and is almost always present in a normal head CT unless the patient is incorrectly positioned with the head cocked at an angle.
