McMurray's Test - Lateral Meniscus 1. Return knee to fully flexed position, turn foot inwards (inverted). 2. Direct knee so pointed inward. 3. Hand on knee, fingers along joint lines 4. Extend and flex knee. 5. If lateral meniscal injury Æ feel "click" w/fingers on joint line; May also elicit pain. Note: McMurray's Test for medial

As described below, what is the special test and if positive, what is it indicative of? With patient lying on the unaffected side and the knee and hip flexed to 90 degree, stabilize the pelvis with one hand and use the other hand to apply flexion, adduction and internal rotation pressure at the knee by pushing into the exam table

Perform the specialist tests which assess the cruciate ligaments. Anterior drawer test: Flex the knee to 90 degrees and sit on the patient's foot. Pull forward on the tibia just distal to the knee.

Musculo-Skeletal Examination. In the setting of acute injury and pain, it's often very difficult to assess a joint as patient "protects" the affected area, limiting movement and thus your examination. It helps to examine the unaffected side first (gain patient's confidence, develop sense of their normal).
