Because UVB rays are shorter and have a higher frequency, they are more damaging to skin as they penetrate the epidermis (top layer of skin). UVB radiation causes sunburns and delayed tanning. It plays a major role in the development of all types of skin cancers causing DNA damage to skin cells and the immune system.

All skin types are at risk of skin cancer and everyone should be mindful of warning signs. The Fitzpatrick skin type scale classifies skin into six separate categories based on color and response to sunlight. Type I is the lightest in color and most sensitive to sun exposure; type VI is the darkest and most sun-resistant.
