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AMA adopts new guidance for ethical practice in telemedicine

Telehealth is only a covered benefit if the originating site is: A county outside of a Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) A rural Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA) located in a rural census tract; In addition, sites that participate in a federal telemedicine demonstration program qualify as originating sites in most cases.
