You generally have two options for filing your Form N-400 with USCIS: Online, or By mail (paper). 1. Filing your Form N-400 online. If you are applying based on your military service, are applying from outside of the U.S., or are applying for a fee waiver or reduced fee, you cannot file your Form N-400 online.
