The technical theory of art says that all art is a means to some end. Knowing that end, the makers of art are practicing a craft, because they are making an artifact in order to satisfy a pre-determined end. (An artifact is a material thing that is designed and made by a human being.)

Philosophy of art. The Principles of Art (1938) comprises Collingwood's most developed treatment of aesthetic questions. Collingwood held (following Benedetto Croce) that works of art are essentially expressions of emotion. For Collingwood, an important social role for artists is to clarify and articulate emotions from their community.

In 1937 he wrote The Principles of Art ; whilst correcting the proofs he suffered a stroke, the first of many to come. From this time onwards he was aware that he was writing on borrowed time. His An Autobiography (1939) records his determination to put on record an account of the work he hoped to do but might not live to complete.
