Evening Invitations. For invites being sent to evening only guests you'll need to slightly amend the wording to reflect that by changing the start time, venue (if necessary) and make sure that you include the words "Evening Reception" in the wording to avoid confusion and make it clear that this is an invitation to the evening only.
