For saltwater aquariums, the temperature for most reef fish should be 72- 78 F (22- 26 C) and can be measured with a thermometer or programable heater. You can also choose to keep cold water aquariums that require chillers and water temp can vary depending on the organism. Coldwater reef tanks need chillers to keep the water temperature in check.
